SLCo Zoo, Arts, and Parks 2006 Tier II Funding Recommendations

Salt Lake County announces that the Zoo, Arts and Parks' Tier II Advisory Board recommends funding 114 cultural organizations for 2006. These organizations provide a diverse selection of cultural activities from arts and ethnic festivals, music, dance, theatre, arts education, botanical, history, media, visual and literary activities and events.

Funding is allocated through a competitive process, overseen by a volunteer advisory board. Organizations applying must have non-profit 501(C)(3) status or be a municipal arts/humanities council. The nine member advisory board met 6 times over several months to review each application. Organizations must have audited financial statements in order to receive amounts over \$10,000.

The Zoo, Arts and Parks program provides opportunities for citizens to enjoy the various arts and cultural programs offered throughout the valley. In November 1996, Salt Lake County voters approved a ballot initiative designed to fund local recreational facilities as well as botanical, cultural and zoological organizations for ten years. The measure was reauthorized in 2004 for an additional ten years. Salt Lake County collects one penny on every ten dollars spent within Salt Lake County to fund the Zoo, Arts and Park program.
